## Jobskat

Refugees and long-term unemployed people have a hard time to get back onto the job market. A lot of teenagers do not know either what job they want to do later in life. Our game provides information about different jobs and the preconditions you need.

For each player there has to be a full quartet in the game. The 4 blank cards have to be separated from the quartets first. The other cards are given a shuffle and handed out to the players covertly. Each player gets 4 playing cards. They pick up the cards and have a look at them.

When all players have their cards, they choose one card they do not need and put it onto the table covertly. Now those cards are pushed counterclockwise towards the next player who picks up the card. Once again the players choose a card they do not need and put it onto the table.

This procedure has to be repeated until one player has a full quartet. This player has to put his hand into the middle of the table. All the other players have to react quickly and also put their hand onto the hand of the first player. When all players have done so, the player who has the quartet has to put his cards onto the table covertly and name the contents of the cards.

Only if he is able to name all the cards' contents, he will get the maximum number of points, which corresponds to the number of players. If he was not able to do so, he will receive one point less. All the other players receive one point less from the maximum for each hand under theirs.

The round is over. The cards are given a new shuffle in order to put them onto the table as a stack covertly. Then the upper card of the stack is taken out of the game covertly. It gets exchanged with one of the blank cards which is mixed into the stack randomly. In case you play more than 5 rounds, it is also possible to exchange cards with previously exchanged cards from the 6th round on, to keep variety.

Furthermore, there is the chance that there are all 4 blank cards in the current game at this point in time. This opens up the possibility to collect a quartet of all blank cards. If a player achieves this, he does not have to name any contents of the cards but instead he can set the points of any player of his choice to 0. Keep in mind that both players will not receive any points for this round.

A new round begins and the cards are handed out again to the players covertly.

## End of the game

You may play as many rounds as you want to. It is also possible to play continuing rounds after no blank cards are left. The player with the highest score after all rounds wins.
